

SALE CONDITIONS

2019 Salt Water Simmental Sale

Entry Deadline: August 16, 2019

- ❖ The sale will be held at the Nappan Bull Test Station, Nova Scotia on SATURDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2019. The sale begins at 12:30 pm.
- ❖ A non-refundable entry fee of \$30.00 per animal must accompany each entry. Post dated cheques will not be accepted.
- ❖ A copy of registration papers must accompany the entry form for registered animals.
- ❖ All sale photos will be taken by Jill Renton. If the consignor does not have Jill Renton take a photo, their consignment will be entered in the catalogue without a picture.
- ❖ Entries will be subject to approval by the Sale Committee. Consignors will receive notification by September 30, 2019 that their animal is in the sale.
- ❖ Substitutions are not permitted.
- ❖ Commission will be a minimum of 5%, but may be higher to cover expenses.
- ❖ The sale is open to fullblood, purebred and commercial females having at least 50% Simmental blood. All females must be no more than five years old.
- ❖ Sale order will be determined by the sale committee.
- ❖ All animals must have a national identification tag.
- ❖ Registration certificate and signed transfer must be given to the MSA Treasurer (Marlene Gaunce) on sale day.
- ❖ Tattoos will be checked prior to the sale. Any consignment without a readable tattoo or whose registration is pending will be sold as a commercial animal.
- ❖ Bred heifers and cows must be guaranteed safe in calf with a vet certificate.
- ❖ Any disputes after purchase will be handled between consignor and buyer.
- ❖ Sale consignors are responsible for ensuring that their cattle are clean, healthy, manageable, and halter broken.
- ❖ All cattle must be penned by 10:00 am on sale day.
- ❖ The sale committee reserves the right to reject any animal arriving for sale that fails to meet the above requirements.
- ❖ Arrangements for the delivery of animals must be made between buyer and consignor immediately following the sale.
- ❖ No consignments may be removed from the premises until full payment is made to the Maritime Simmental Association. Consignors will be paid by the Maritime Simmental Association as soon as possible, following the sale.
- ❖ The sale is being held in conjunction with the *Angus in Action*, *Atlantic Bonus Hereford* and *Autumn Classic Shorthorn* Sales. Simmentals will be the final breed to sell and will be penned in the outer barns of the Nappan Bull Test Station.
